© Purpose of the Uniform Policy

At Cornelia International Schools, our uniform reflects our identity, encourages a sense of belonging, and promotes equality, discipline, and pride in appearance. This policy outlines expectations for student dress from Pre-Nursery through Year 6, ensuring consistency and clarity across all year groups.

Uniform Guidelines by Section

Pre-Nursery to Reception (Ages 2–5)

(Worn Monday - Wednesday)

• Girls:

- o Blue gingham dress
- Navy blue polo dress (alternative)
- o Red cardigan/sweatshirt embroidered with school logo
- White knee-length socks or pantyhose
- Black school shoes

Boys:

- Grey school shorts
- White polo shirt embroidered with school logo
- Sky blue short-sleeved shirt (alternative)
- Red cardigan/sweatshirt embroidered with school logo
- White crew socks
- Black school shoes

Material Series Year 1 to Year 6 (Ages 5–11)

(Worn Monday - Wednesday)

• Girls:

- Grey pinafore
- White lace collar shirt
- Sky blue short-sleeved shirt
- o Red cardigan/sweatshirt embroidered with school logo
- Black knee-length socks or pantyhose
- Black school shoes (no trainers)

Boys:

- Grey school shorts
- White and/or sky blue short-sleeved shirt
- Blue pinstriped school tie (elastic or clip version)
- Red cardigan/sweatshirt embroidered with school logo
- Black crew socks
- Black school shoes (no trainers)

№ Physical Education Days (Thursdays)

All pupils must come to school dressed in the full PE kit on Thursdays.

- Sky blue polo shirt embroidered with school logo
- Navy blue shorts
- White ankle-length socks
- White Trainers (no sandals or slippers)

Spirit Wear Days (Fridays)

Fridays are Spirit Days when pupils wear house or school spirit clothing.

- Navy polo shirt with school logo or respective house wear
- Blue jeans
- Trainers with white ankle-length socks

Mair and Grooming

- Hair must be neatly made, shoulder-length or shorter, and free of colourful extensions.
- Hairstyles should be simple and not disrupt learning.
- Extreme haircuts, bright dyes, or fashion styles are not permitted.
- Hair accessories, if worn, must be small and in school colours.

Jewelry and Accessories

- Only small stud earrings (girls only) and a wristwatch are allowed.
- No other jewellery is permitted.
- Earrings must be removed during PE, Games, or Swimming.
- Dangling earrings, large accessories, and makeup are strictly prohibited.

Weather Considerations

- During the rainy season, students are advised to come to school with labelled raincoats.
- Branded school sweaters or cardigans are recommended during cold months.

Swimming Days

(For Primary classes only — as scheduled)

- Pupils are required to bring:
 - Swimwear
 - Towel
 - Slippers
 - Swim cap (if applicable)

All items must be clearly labelled.

Purchasing Uniforms

- Uniforms are available from the school office or the online uniform store.
- To purchase:
 - 1. Complete the **Uniform Order Form** (available at the school or by request)
 - 2. Submit the form and full payment at the school office

Uniforms should be purchased **before the start of term**, especially for students transitioning to a new year group.

Non-Compliance

Parents will be notified if their child does not comply with uniform expectations. Continued non-compliance may result in:

- Reminders or written warnings
- Request to return home to change
- Suspension from special events or assemblies

- All clothing and accessories **must be clearly labelled** with the child's full name.
- Parents are encouraged to purchase at least two full sets of uniforms for convenience.
- Children in daycare and crèche do not have a formal uniform but must wear comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing.
